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1 Application area

The connection set for air/water heat exchangers is used to ensure professional cooling water connections and volumetric flow control. The set is compatible with all Rittal TopTherm air/water heat exchangers with Model Nos. 3209.XX0, 3210.XX0, 3364.XX0, 3373.XX0, 3374.XX0 , **3216.480**, 3375.XX0.

2 Connection and assembly

2.1 Connection

Remove the connector sleeves and flat seals attached to the device (not required with 3209.XX0 and 3210.XX0).



Fig. 1: Remove the connector sleeve



Note:

When loosening the connector sleeve, it is very important to secure the device fitting using an SW22 spanner. Otherwise, the connection in the device could leak.

Attach the G ³/₈ x G ³/₄ adaptor included with the set to the cooling water inlet and return. Hand-tighten the adaptors, then tighten a further half-turn using an SW19 spanner.



Fig. 2: Attach the adaptor

Insert the supplied PTFE seals into the G³/₄" union nuts.

- Please note, that the PU-seals are present in the fittings.
- Hand-tighten the union nut of the adaptor, then tighten a further half-turn using an SW32 spanner.
- Attach the pressure hose for the cooling water return in the same way.

- 1 PU seal
- 2 Cooling water **inlet**
- 3 Cooling water **return**



Note:

Before tightening the union nuts, please ensure that the display and the dial of the flow regulator valve are pointing forwards.

Note:

To achieve full cooling performance, the water flowrate should be regulated to 400 l/h.

- If necessary, cut the pressure hoses to the required length.
- Insert the ribbed connector sleeve with G ¹/₂["] union nut into the end of the hose, and secure using the heavy duty clamps supplied.

Connect the pressure hoses to the cooling water supply.

2.2 Assembly

The supply includes two hose clamps (including assembly parts) for routing the pressure hoses along the enclosure door or side panel.

Attach the clamps to the enclosure using the washers and self-tapping screws included with the supply.

Caution!

We do not advise attaching the hose clamps to the air/ water heat exchanger, due to the risk of damaging the heat exchanger package.
